Smithville Regional Hospital selects Constructors to oversee \$7 million Hospital expansion project

In a special called evening session on January 15th, Smithville Regional Hospital's Board of Directors selected Constructors, a project management company out of Austin, to oversee the Hospital's \$7 million dollar expansion project.

"We have completely outgrown our current space and the need to expand is essential," said Dennis Jack, Hospital CEO. "Our new facilities will consist of consolidating imaging services, expanding the emergency department, creating new obstetrics space and increasing outpatient capabilities by adding 29,000 square feet to the existing building."

"We believe expanding our current facilities is important for both the hospital and the communities we serve," said Jack. "This project will also enhance the hospital's productivity, quality and efficiency."
